Education meets Construction**

Rick and Chris Conard will present about Nkonya, Uganda where they helped construct a teacher dormitory. Nkonya is a remote fishing village in Uganda, East Africa. In 2005 a school was built, however, the teachers had to travel five miles over dirt roads from the closest city, Mityana. During the monsoon season, teachers could not reach the village and the school closed. Because these intermittent closures were so disruptive the solution was to build a teacher dormitory in Nkonya.
